

FROM THE PRINCIPAL

Dear Parents and Community Members,

During the 2015-2016 school year, all students in the state took the statewide assessment called Smarter Balanced. The Smarter Balanced assessment is aligned with the Common Core State Standards taught and is a more in-depth assessment than previously used assessments. These content standards set high expectations for students. This means that expectations for student achievement are higher than they used to be. As a result, it is likely that fewer students will score at the higher achievement levels on the assessments, especially in the first few years of implementation. Results should improve as students have more years of instruction based on the new standards.

This was the second year the assessment was given, and no school received an overall State School Report Card Rating. However, you will see school wide results on the following pages but **no overall ratings were given to schools this year.**

Based on the results reported, Judson Middle School reported:

- English Language Arts 67% met/exceeded state standards
- Math 48% met/exceeded state standards

Judson did receive a **Level 4** rating (scale 1-5) in the following areas:

- Academic Achievement

- Academic Growth

- Student Group Growth

As part of our efforts to increase academic success for all of our students and to provide targeted instruction for our students in grades 6-8, our teachers have received additional training this summer to provide even higher quality instruction in our classrooms in English Language Arts and math. By continuing to focus on student growth and achievement we will strive to meet the learning needs of all of our students across all content areas.

You can continue to support our efforts by: checking your child's student planner every evening, monitoring homework, encouraging your child to read daily, and by communicating with our staff. 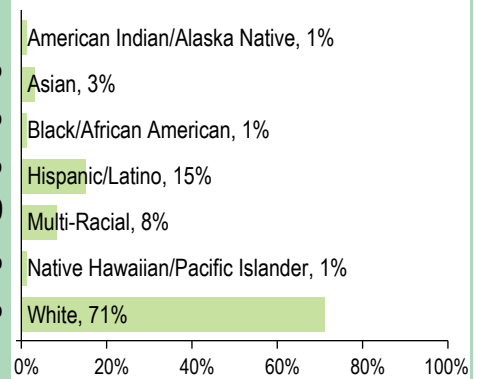

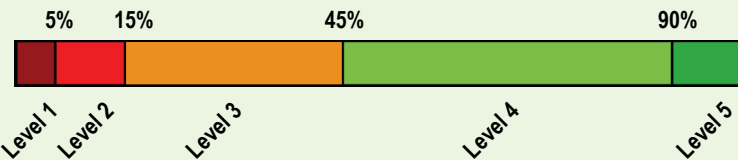
