

## FROM THE PRINCIPAL

Dear Parents and Community Members,

At Liberty Elementary, we have been focusing on instructing students in a manner that meets their individual needs, as well as ensuring a deep implementation of the Common Core State Standards (CCSS). Students in 3rd, 4th, and 5th grade have been taking the Smarter Balanced Assessment for the third consecutive year in the areas of Literacy and Math in the Spring. At this time, Liberty Elementary, along with other schools in the state of Oregon received a "Not Rated" Overall State Report Card Rating. However, our school received ratings in each of the following categories:

- Academic Achievement: Level 3 - 60% points earned
- Academic Growth: Level 4 - 80.0% points earned
- Student Group Growth: Level 3 – 66.7% points earned

We have seen academic growth in our reading and math scores among all our students. The subgroup of Students with Disabilities moved from Level 1 to Level 3. We will continue to monitor the academic growth of all our students to ensure that it improves again for this coming school year. In summary, what these ratings mean is that our students are achieving significant academic growth. This academic growth will enable our students to achieve grade level benchmark scores in the future.

Thank you for continuing to be our partner in supporting your child's education by participating in school events, reading with your child every day, attending Parent-Teacher Conferences, and maintaining constant communication with your child's teacher. By working together, we will make a difference and ensure the success of each of our students.

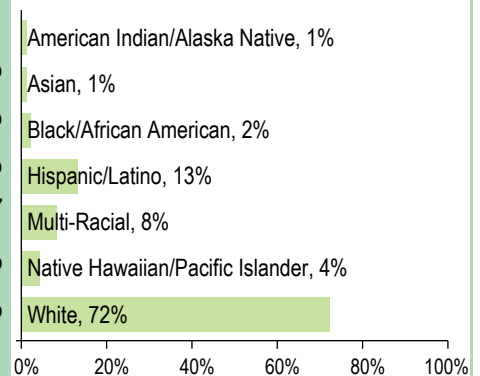
